Thank you for taking the time to respond to our recent Year 7 survey to help us understand how families feel about the first HT Parents' Evening for your child(ren). We were delighted with the responses received and the positive views about the provision for our Year 7 cohort. We also received some helpful and informative insightful comments about how we can ensure we can plan for future Parents' Evenings to ensure this is as efficient as possible.

A summary of the survey results from 33 responses are shown below.
