Haileybury Turnford is an oversubscribed six form entry, 11-19 mixed academy that opened on 1st September 2015. Our new school launched a change in aspirations, drive and standards of achievement for our students and the wider community. Our students will leave Haileybury Turnford knowing they have achieved their personal best and with qualifications that will ensure they progress confidently to college, university and employment.

# Exam Results – Sustained improvements at HT

In 2023 our Year 11 students achieved the best results in the school's history, building on the previous improvements in 2022 compared to before the pandemic. In 2023 we had the highest GCSE English and Maths exam results we have ever had as well as wider success across the whole curriculum. Sixth Form students have continued to successfully reach their first choice destinations, including places at the University of Oxford, Imperial College London and the University of Warwick, and to competitive apprenticeships and employment in 2023.

In 2022 all students who wished to, progressed to university following their exam results. Our Progress Score for A Level Performance in 2019 was the highest progress score amongst local 16-18 state school provision and ranked us 26<sup>th</sup> out of 125 Hertfordshire 16-18 providers and 16<sup>th</sup> for academies and maintained schools. Our vocational qualifications have continued their strong performances with outcomes remaining high. We continue to have real student success across the range of vocational subjects offered with many top grades achieved in Business, ICT, Health & Social Care and Drama.

At GCSE, our students had great success in 2022 across a wide range of subjects including in English, Maths, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Business, Engineering, Geography and History. Our Progress 8 score for all Year 11 students was -0.13. 63% of our students achieved both at least a grade 4 in Maths and English, with significantly higher outcomes in both Maths and English individually. Our Progress score for Maths was +0.25, showing exceptional progress for our students of all abilities.

# **Staff Wellbeing and Benefits**

Looking after our staff is very important at Haileybury Turnford and we want all staff to love working here. The school offers all its staff a range of benefits including the following ones below.

#### **Recruitment Incentives**

### **Professional Development Opportunities**

We offer excellent induction and training to support professional development to all teaching and support staff. We have programmes in place for Early Career Teachers, as well as aspiring Middle Leaders and Senior Leaders. There are also opportunities to work with teaching and support staff at our sponsor, Haileybury. Support staff are also well catered for with specific training to support individual roles. There are also additional coaching and research opportunities available to help support our teaching and learning culture in the school. We work with a range of different teacher training providers which gives mentoring opportunities to a number of our staff.

### Wellbeing

Staff wellbeing is very important at HT. We launched our Staff Wellbeing Charter in September 2021 to show the central importance of this commitment to all staff, building on the work carried out in recent years. We are a happy, cohesive staff, and we believe this teamwork makes HT an excellent place to work.

Free flu jabs and other wellbeing support, advice, confidential information and counselling is provided. Our Staff Room was recently fully reburbished. There are also regular Staff Forum & Wellbeing Meetings, Wellbeing Wednesdays and a staff Diversity Forum focused on ensuring we have the best possible working environment for all staff.
