- PE kit if necessary

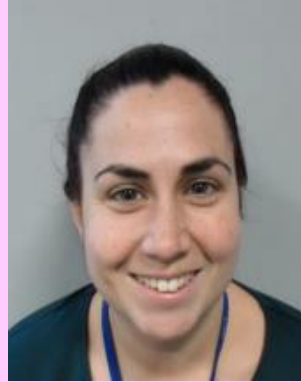
