

We were lucky enough to travel to Wittering RAF Base and be hosted by numerous roles at the RAF. It was a versatile day, getting to witness a base and where the RAF live, understand about reduced renting cost as well as the different flats and house that are available. We were visited RAF Police, RAF Caterers in the morning. These both gave us a different insight into careers within the RAF, due to how different they are in comparison to Civilian Caterers and Police. We also saw Air Engineers and did some challenges. Kyron came out on top showing his strength and engineering masterclass. We understood how you can fast track your qualifications through the RAF, for example joining the RAF after 6th form they will pay for your degree and allow you to travel the world and progress quicker than in industry and gaining top qualifications without the debt! We also met the ground engineers and got to experience some of their trucks. Most of us sat in a fighter jet and we all got involved in a RAF Physical Training Session and understood the different disciplines within Physical Training and how RAF can specialise. It was an eye-opening day with lots of information and the students really enjoyed it.

- Mock small group teaching session






