Health care: Nursing, GP, Surgeon, Midwife, Paramedic, Matron, Clinical support worker, Physiotherapist

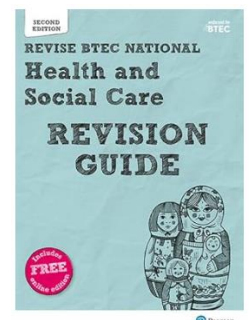
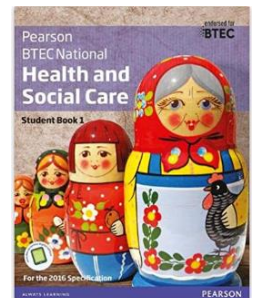
Social care: Counsellor, Social worker, Family support worker, Adult social care, Occupational Health...
