Awards for local secondary school, Haileybury Turnford

Haileybury Turnford has received national recognition for its school community in this year's Pearson National Teaching Awards.



Haileybury Turnford was awarded with two Certificates of Excellence:

The Award for Making a Difference - Secondary School of the Year

This is awarded to a secondary school that can demonstrate its power and effectiveness not only in transforming the life chances of local children but also in enriching the local community. Certificates of Excellence are awarded to schools that work with their communities creatively and constructively and are seen as models of good secondary practice professionally with an established record of strong academic outcomes.

The Award for Unsung Hero for Mrs Carter, for her work with Year 11

This is awarded to a member of staff in schools and colleges across the UK who repeatedly go above and beyond. The Unsung Hero Award recognises anyone on the staff team who has positively enhanced the lives of others in their school community; those who work quietly behind the scenes with a positive attitude, a willingness to help in whatever capacity necessary and a commitment in doing so, to a high standard. This award is for those individuals who consistently go the extra mile.
