Dear Parent/Carer

Following an excellent Transition day last Thursday, we are now in a position to share with you further details about our Summer school programme on Monday 19th August and Tuesday 20th August.

This will be a fantastic opportunity for your child to work alongside the rest of their new year group and meet some of the staff, ahead of starting school in September. Lunch will be provided on all days, but it will be useful for students to bring a bottle of water, each day.

Students will need to be dropped off at the school by 9.00am each morning and the day will end at 2.00pm. Students will need to bring normal school equipment for the sessions. We also advise that students bring a waterproof, suntan lotion and a hat. Students should wear suitable clothing such as sports clothing as there will be a variety of activities including Physical Education.

Enclosed is a medical form which must be completed and returned to Haileybury Turnford either by hand, marked for the attention of Mrs R Davey, or as an email sent to daveyr@haileyburyturnford.com. This must be returned prior to the Summer school to ensure that all food intolerances and allergies can be taken into consideration.

We are also holding a Key to Success event on Monday 9th September at 5.00 pm. This evening is an important opportunity for parents and carers to meet with your child's pastoral staff to understand how the school will support your child through the next stage of their education.
