“What is it about?”

- We want to examine the relationship between young people’s travel behaviour, physical activity, and wellbeing

“Why am I being invited to take part?”

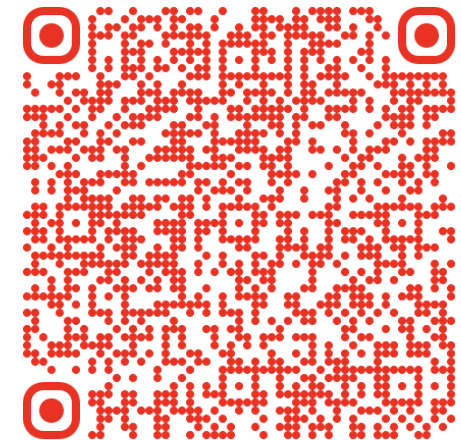
- You are aged 11-19 years of age and attend a secondary school or college

“What will happen if I take part?”

- You and your parent/carer will **log into an online survey**. You will both read an online information sheet, and will provide your joint consent to take part, if you are still willing at that stage. **The survey will take ~20 minutes to complete.**
- You will both provide personal information, details of your cycling qualifications, experience and attitudes, and your travel behaviour
- You will detail your physical activity levels and your subjective wellbeing. Your parent/carer will indicate their satisfaction with their household circumstances
- You will be entered into a **prize draw for one of twenty £50 Amazon gift cards**

SURVEY PASSWORD: modeshift (all lowercase)
