Action Required

Hertfordshire County Council (HCC) would ask all schools to support families within these groups (who wish to apply for a FSM) by completing <u>sample</u> FSM application form. Completed forms to be sent to <u>freeschoolmeals@hertfordshire.gov.uk</u>.

HCC will assess the application and contact the school with the decision. The school should then inform the family of the outcome and retain a copy of the application for their records.

Note: We are not able to use the eligibility checking system (ECS) to confirm eligibility for these families as they will not be in receipt of UC or legacy benefits. Therefore, please do not submit an online application via the free school meals website.
