- Continue to develop approaches to manage the behaviour of students, to ensure specific students can be more self-disciplined and respectful to others

We will continue to develop our approaches to teaching and learning, and pastoral care, to ensure this provision is as effective as possible for all students. This is supported by regular professional development for our staff, and work with our students to help them to be as self-disciplined, respectful and kind to others at all times.

Homework is an area we are continuing to focus on, ensuring the homework activities set fully support student progress. In addition, do look at your child's exercise books with them, which will show their learning in further detail, and also show where they have completed feedback to help their further acquisition of knowledge, skills and understanding.

We will provide further updates about the Department for Education's School Rebuilding Programme in the weeks and months ahead. The Department for Education is about to go through the process of appointing the contractor, and planning permission will follow that process during the next few months of this calendar year. We will be able to share detailed plans once planning permission is been applied for. We are fortunate that all existing buildings will be replaced, other than K Building which opened in autumn 2021.
