KS4 PE kit procedure and expectations

Physical activity is not only beneficial for physical health but just as important for mental health too. As per the National Curriculum, students in Years 10-11 have two PE lessons across their two-week timetable which cover a variety of different sports and activities. Our curriculum enables students to improve their physical skills and abilities in these activities, as well as develop their personal skills such as teamwork, organisation and leadership.

To ensure that all students have consistent access to this opportunity, our PE kit procedure and expectations ensure that we are able to fully support students' physical and mental wellbeing.

If your child cannot take part in a PE lesson for medical reasons, a note or email that explains the reason for exemption is required from **parents/carers before 8.30am** on the day of the lesson. Furthermore, long term exemption (1 week or more) must be accompanied by a GP or valid medical/hospital letter.

If students fail to bring their PE kit to lessons without providing a valid note or email explanation, they will incur the following sanction and consequence which adheres to the expectations set out in our Rewards, Behaviour and Discipline Policy.

• Each lesson missed due to not having PE kit = 1-hour payback and phone call home

Please ensure that your child has their PE kit with them for the timetabled PE lessons.

Year 11 lessons may be impacted due to subject interventions in the lead up to exams season.
