

INTELLECTUAL DEVELOPMENT

- Aware of others shapes and his own
- Doesn't want to know about bulimia
- Made aware of putting weight on via articles in newspaper
- Change of mindset 'played alright for a fat lad'
- Link between success of weight loss and success on pitch

EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Low <u>self image</u> does not want to gain weight
- <u>Discontent</u> feels he will never be an ideal weight
- Weight loss reinforced by others
- Enjoyed the results
