



What has gone well?

- Year 10 behaviour improved students fed back they noticed a big improvement and students want to learn and do well in their subjects they have chosen.
- The Fire Drill and practice on 25.09.25 was carried out sensibly and students knew the routines and what was expected of them.
- The school feels safe at lunchtime and breaktime because of the staff supporting on duty and sensible behaviour.
- The toilets are safe areas as staff are on duty
- Behaviour really good in class.
- Y12 and 13 work well together.
- Teachers are teaching us revision methods.
- Co-curricular needs to be more diversified and promoted.
- The interventions for Y11 are helpful.

Even better next time?

- The canteen queuing in the large dining Hall is not always good especially near to the tills there is a lot of pushing in and students not queuing which is not fair.
- Some students are using poor language around the school.
- Some students are not participating in class as much as others.
- The uniform is not always worn correctly.
