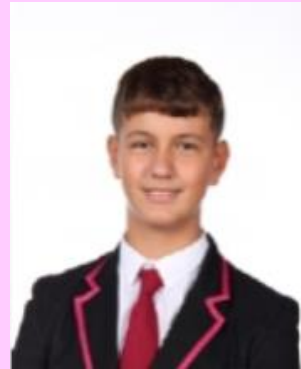

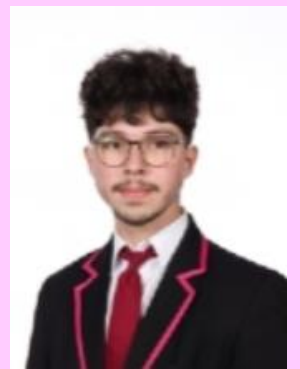

What has gone well?	Even better next time?
• Year 10 behaviour improved – students in Y10 fed back they noticed a big improvement and students want to learn and do well in their subjects they have chosen. • The Fire Drill and practice on 25.09.25 was carried out sensibly. • Students knew the routines and what was expected of them. • The school feels safe at lunchtime and breaktime because of the staff supporting on duty and sensible behaviour from most. • The toilets are safe areas as staff are on duty. • Behaviour is really good in most classes. • Teachers are teaching us helpful revision methods. • The interventions for Y11 are helpful.	• The canteen queuing in the large dining Hall is not always good especially near to the tills there is a lot of pushing in and students not queuing which is not fair. • Some students are using poor language around the school. • Some students are not participating in class as much as others. • The uniform is not always worn correctly. • Can we clarify which toilets are for which Year groups. • Display and advertise who the Student Leaders are in classrooms and during assembly time and on class charts. • Co-curricular needs to be more diversified and promoted. • Clarify the toilet areas for each year group.

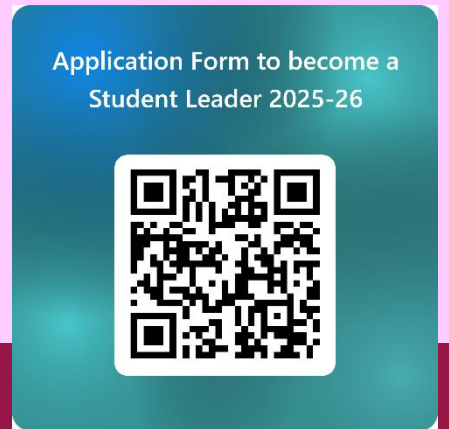
