- Progress reports will be sent home 3 times a year, with both where they are on the HT Standard and their Attitude to Learning.

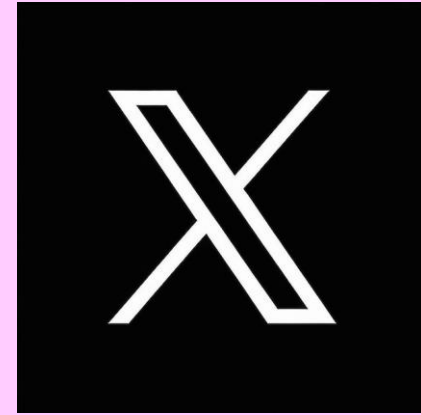

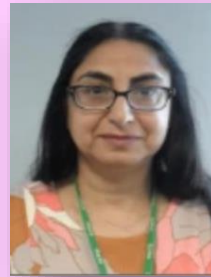
