## **Further comments:**

We didn't get to see all teachers and there were some very long waits. Maybe consider doing two Parents' Evenings.

Short written targets/to do list to take home so we know what's needed to be done for each subject.

Add a further Parents' Evening.

Further written feedback and/or targets from recent assessments to support next steps and areas for improvement, along with practical advice on how to help my child at home.

Be more disciplined with the time allowed to ensure no one misses their scheduled slot.

Longer appointment slots, for example, 10 minutes per teacher.

Allow more time with/between appointments.

## You said ... We did:

It is very difficult to run Parents' Evening without some issues with timings. There is a second Parents' Evening for Year 11 families later in the academic year, on **Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2026**. Our advice is to prioritise subjects at this second evening to provide the most useful and targeted support required prior to the summer's exams.

We would also encourage parents/carers to look at your child's work with them in their exercise books and work folders throughout the academic year, and to ask them to show you the feedback received from assessments and targets for improvement that staff share with them.

Please do stay in contact with the Year 11 Pastoral team, to enable us to provide the best support that we can give.
