Thank you for taking the time to respond to our recent Year 7 survey to help us understand how families feel about the first half-term at Haileybury Turnford for your child(ren). We were very pleased to receive the positive views about the provision for our new Year 7 cohort.

A summary of the survey results from the responses are shown below.
