You said ... We did:

We encourage parents and carers to regularly discuss their child's progress at school and to review their subject folders together, asking to see examples of assessed work. In addition, parents and carers are encouraged to contact subject teachers at any point during the academic year if they have any concerns. We will also remind staff to ensure they are using ClassCharts to provide feedback to families, as well as contacting home by telephone or email to share both positive news and any concerns.
