Year 11 Parents' Evening Feedback

Thank you to families for your feedback to our survey following the recent Year 11 Parents' Evening.

I wanted to share the responses to our survey (from 23 families):

A summary of further comments:

Instead of QR codes and most of the revision sources being online, I think it would be good to have more paper information and past papers on actual paper.

Having all the results and marked exam papers for the recent mock exams; consider moving the date of Parents' Evening to when the results are guaranteed to be available.

It was good the way Parents' Evening was conducted – all was very clear and ran well.

Possibly look at scheduling.

More examples of work. Only some staff showed me my child's work.

I cannot think of anything further ... every teacher had a full knowledge of my child and gave her support on strengths and gave excellent advice to support areas to further develop.

I just wanted to say you can tell how much the teachers want their students to do well. My child is incredibly lucky to have amazing Year 11 teachers that care so much - please pass on my thanks and gratitude.

You said ... we did:

It was difficult to schedule Parents' Evening prior to the Easter break with this half-term being so short due to Easter being very early this year. We made the decision to hold Parents' Evening prior to the Easter break, and Progress Updates with all mock exam results will be issued to students and families before the end of term this Friday. We would encourage families to contact specific teachers further immediately after Easter should you wish to.

Following feedback from previous Year 11 cohorts, we have developed one specific place as a Revision Hub for students, to help them quickly find the relevant resources to support their revision. The QR Code is again published below for easy access. Paper copies of exam papers will also be provided by specific teachers as required.

It is always incredibly difficult for Parents' Evening to run to time for everybody. We have recently introduced changes to our scheduling software so that families are only able to make appointments every 10 minutes, meaning a 5-minute gap between each appointment for families. There is evidence that this has helped with scheduling, but we recognise not all appointments still run to time.

We wish all students well with their revision, and our best wishes with the summer's exams once they arrive. There will be a wide range of revision sessions for students in the coming weeks, in addition to revision activities which will take place in lessons after the Easter break.
