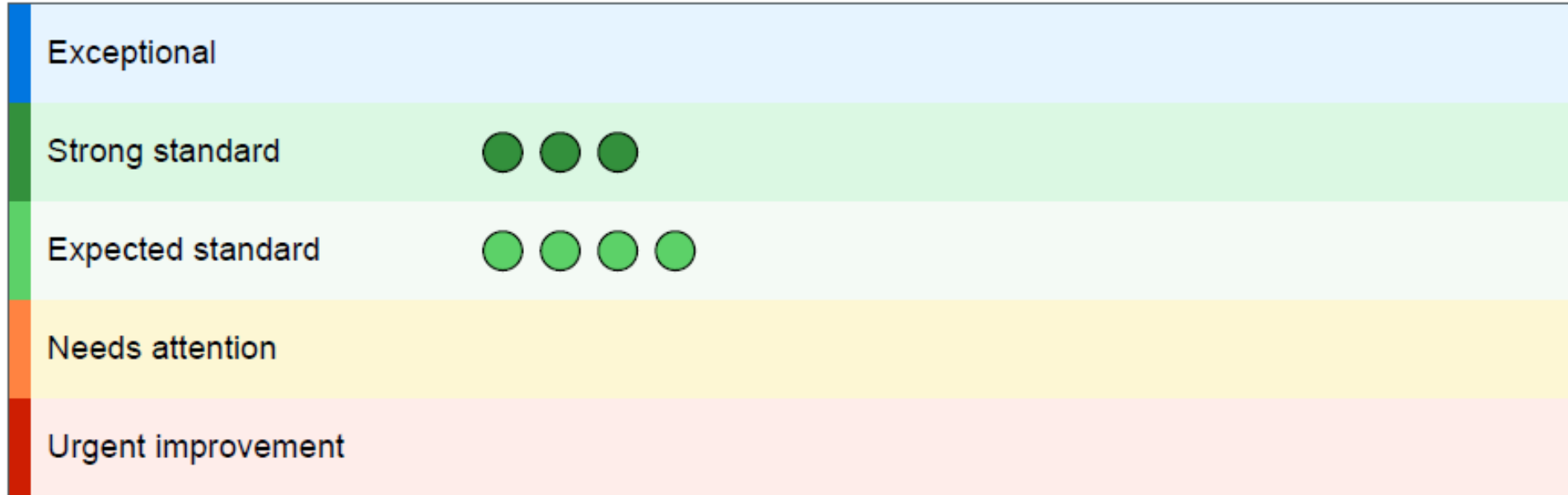

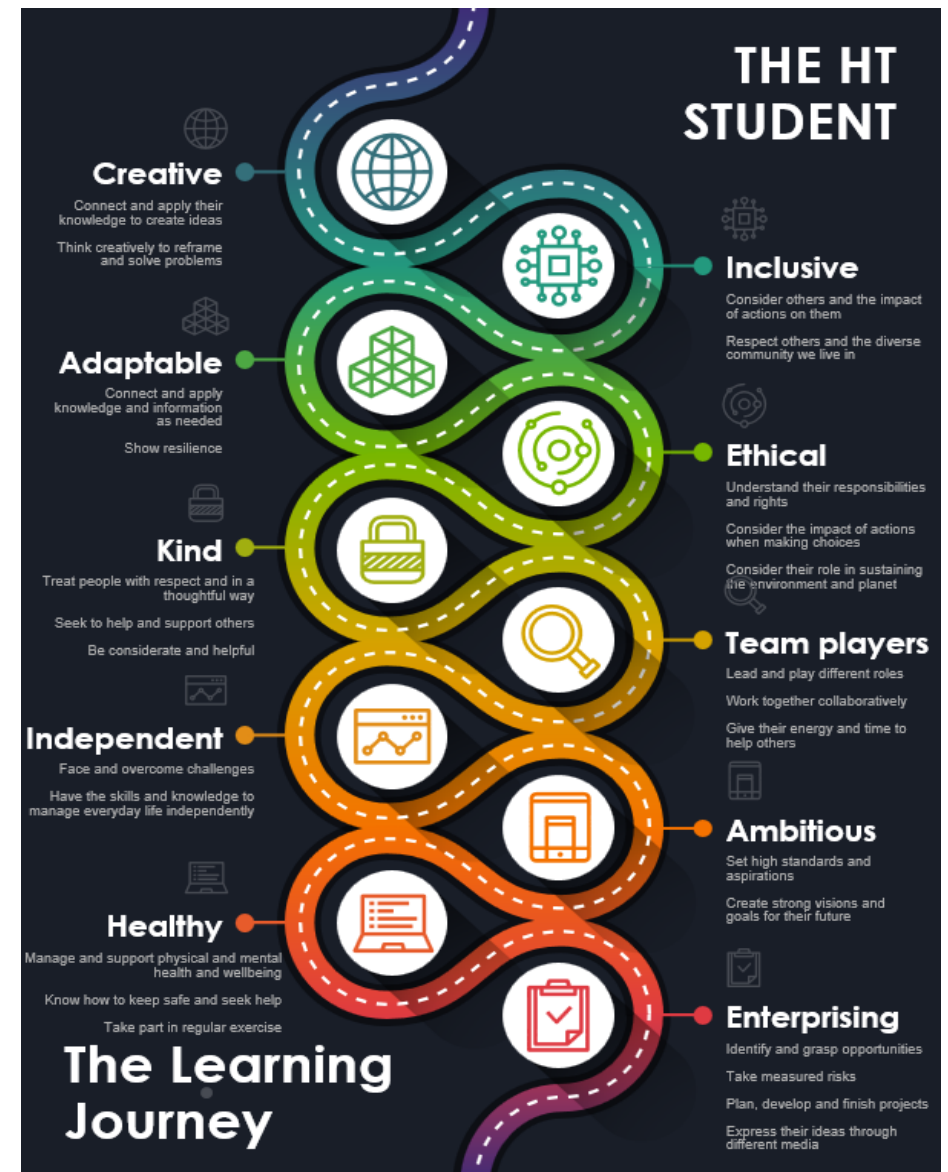

# Ready for learning: Attendance

**Good attendance and punctuality  
improves chances of success**

- Good attendance and punctuality are essential if your child is to achieve their full potential, both academically and socially.
- **Students must arrive by 8.35am**
- **The main school gates will be locked at 8.35am**
- **If a student arrives after 8.35am they will be marked as being late and will be issued with a late payback (detention)**
- **The register will be taken at 8.40am**
- **The school day finishes at 3.05pm**

<b>Red Card</b>	Serious breach of the behaviour code. Removal from the classroom. Parents informed.	<b>6</b> behaviour points



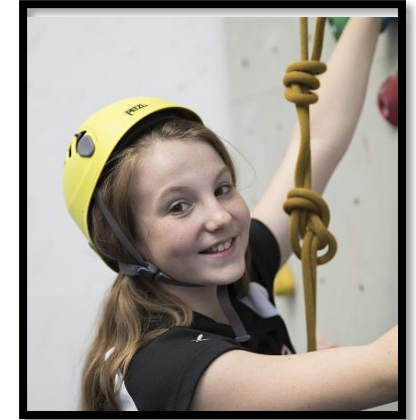

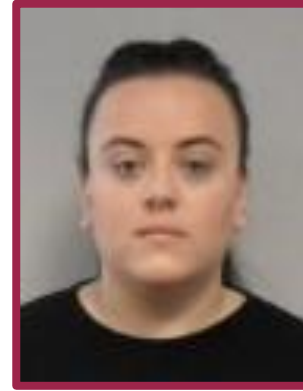
