## Year 10 End of Year Trip – Thorpe Park 2026

To celebrate the end of a successful first phase of Key Stage 4 for our Year 10 students, I am delighted to offer your child the opportunity to attend our end-of-year celebration: a day trip to Thorpe Park. This will take place on **Monday 20th July 2026**. We are pleased to offer this exciting alternative day trip for all Year 10 students.

### Details of the Trip:

- **Date:** Monday 20th July 2026 (the penultimate day of the school year)
- **Time:** 8.30am – students should arrive for registration in the main hall no later than 8.15am
- **Return:** Approximately 6:00pm (any significant changes to this time will be communicated via Class Charts)

Students will not be expected to attend school prior to the stated meeting time. Upon returning to school, they will be directly dismissed from the top end of Mill Lane. Unless communicated otherwise, students will be permitted to make their own way home.

**The cost of the trip is £45.00, which includes coach transportation, admission to Thorpe Park (including access to all rides and attractions), and supervision by our dedicated staff throughout the day.**

### Payment support

Haileybury Turnford is committed to helping as many students as possible take part in the opportunities the school offers. **If your child in receipt of Free School Meals, adopted from care, a Young Carer or if your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium funding**, then there may be some funding support available. We now also have the HT School Fund which parents who are on low incomes can apply to for support. The School Fund is by application to the Principal and Vice Principals. Please note that if funding is agreed, you will still be required to pay all (or part) of the deposit yourself, in order to secure your place on the trip. The amount of funds issued is limited across the academic year.

### Key Information

As we will be off-site for the entire day, students have two options for lunch:

- Bring a packed lunch and suitable drinks or a refillable water bottle – If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, Miss Lee can arrange for a packed lunch to be provided by the school.
- Purchase lunch at the park – Students are welcome to bring money to purchase food on-site. Please note that most vendors at Thorpe Park are now cashless and only accept card payments or Apple Pay/contactless payment.

All students will be provided with an emergency contact card containing the following mobile number: **07719525127**. If a student becomes lost, they can use this number to contact staff so that a member of the team can meet them. Thorpe Park also has trained staff on site to assist lost students. Students should report to any park staff member and inform them that they are lost. The park will have our contact details and will get in touch with us if needed. If you need to contact us during the trip, please use the number above.

### Dress Code

Recognising that this is an all-day trip, students **are not** required to wear school uniform and may come dressed in

their own clothes. However, we ask that parents and carers carefully consider what their child chooses to wear. Appropriate dress is essential: belly tops, overly short shorts, and tank tops are not permitted. Any student deemed to be dressed inappropriately will not be allowed to attend the trip on the day. Given the unpredictable British weather, we also recommend that students bring a light jacket in case of rain and if required ensure your child has appropriate sun cream and sun protection. This can be left on the coach if not needed during the day.

## Behaviour and Attendance Expectations

We have high expectations of student behaviour on all school trips. As such, participation in the Thorpe Park trip is subject to students demonstrating good behaviour/conduct and attendance in school, as well as on any previous/upcoming trips. It is important to note that only students with attendance above 90% will be considered for the trip unless there is a valid reason such as a medical condition which has impacted attendance. While this is a day trip, it still carries significant responsibility, and we must be confident that every student attending will act in a safe, respectful, and responsible manner throughout the day. In addition to behaviour, students must maintain good attendance in line with our school policy to retain their place on the trip. If a student's conduct or attendance is deemed to jeopardise the safety or success of the trip, we reserve the right to withdraw their place. In such cases, any refund of payments made will be subject to the terms and conditions of our travel provider and will be at the school's discretion.

To confirm your child's space on this trip, payment must be made via ParentPay and should be completed no later than **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2026**. Please note that there are only 96 spaces available; once full capacity is reached, the payment portal will close.
